Quick Bio

2 x NSW Champion (Schoolboys Champion in 1974 and Juniors Champion in 1977)
2 x Winner of the Pro Junior (1977 and 1980)
Joined the IPS World Tour and went professional in 1979
Top 5 finish in his 4th year on tour in 1982
Became the first goofyfoot surfer to win the World Title in 1983
Defended his World Title against Shaun Tomson and Tom Curren
2 x World Champion in 1984
Won the Surfer Poll 1984
First ever 3 x Pipe Masters Champion
During Carroll's 1991 win at Pipe, in 8-12 foot surf he executed the most committed late drop and the heaviest under-the-lip snap in history which is still embedded in everyone's minds even today, stamping his unprecedented authority on the wave
In 1988, Carroll earned surfing's first million dollar contract. That same year Carroll look set to reclaim his World Title for the 3rd time but due to an interference call was denied which led Carroll to step back
In 1991 Carroll returned to 3rd in the World Rankings
Carroll racked up 26 tour victories third only to Kelly Slater and Tom Curren
Carroll finished in the top 5 a total of 9 times
